NUT BREAD 1 cake compressed yeast 1 cup milk, scalded and cooled 1 tablespoon sugar 3 cups sifted flour 1-3 cup sugar 2 tablespoons shortening White of 1 egg 1/2 cup chopped walnuts 2-3 teaspoon salt

COCOA FUDGE CAKE 1/2 cup shortening 3/4 cups brown sugar 2 eggs 2-3 cup mashed potato 1 cup flour 1/2 cup cocoa 1-3 teaspoon salt 3 teaspoons baking powder 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg 1-3 cup milk 1-3 cup hot water.
