

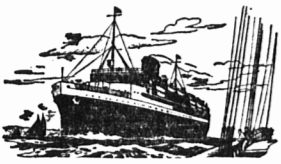

SUNSHINE SCRAMBLED EGGS

Twelve egg yolks, 4 whites, 1-2 cup whole milk, 1 tablespoon butter, 1 teaspoon salt, 1-2 green pepper. Beat eggs slightly, add milk and salt. Pepper to taste. In top of double boiler melt butter, add pepper, chopped fine and cook a few minutes. Then add beaten eggs and stir constantly until soft and creamy - scrambled eggs should be that way, not tough and knobby.
