Mr. McLean, being a Benedict, may plead as an offset that he has done his duty to the state and society in a matter which his opponent has too long neglected.

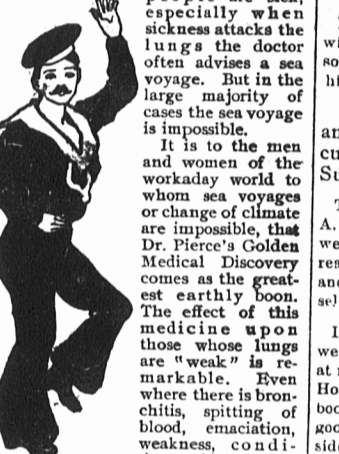
