N. B. LIBERAL CONVENTION.

THE COST OF SCHOOL BOOKS.

The question of the cost and unavailability of the readers in use in schools formed a fruitful topic in political circles in Ontario some years ago, in New Brunswick at the late provincial elections and more recently to some extent in our own Legislature.

No one seemed to have any very accurate knowledge of what it costs all the parents and guardians in the Province for school books in a year.

Mr. Ansley showed as a statement of the school readers and geographies sold by the firm in the Island during the year 1897, the amount for the series of readers being \$2,047.31 and for geographies \$351.90, making a total of \$2,399.21.

It may be assumed that the sales of last year represent approximately the yearly consumption, the prices at wholesale being close upon \$2,400.
