estly admonished that they guard with great care their reputation as servants of Christ, and in the case of those amusements and practices which are of a hurtful and questionable tendency that they do not engage in those injurious to their spiritual life or incompatible to their allegiance to Jesus Christ, their Master.

As stated in yesterday's Globe, the foregoing change when brought before the Conference gave rise to a very keen and at times warm debate. It was proposed by Prof. W. W. Andrews of Sackville, N. B., and seconded by Rev. Dr. J. White of New Westminster.

The moment it was before the Conference excitement rose to fever height. Rev. J. Pitcher of Gananoque moved that the original as well as the new footnote be struck out as being unnecessary, and urging that the rules need no explanation such as the "footnote."

Dr. M. E. Armstrong of Bridgetown, N. S., seconded. Rev. Dr. Speer, Toronto, offered an amendment which was seconded by Rev. Dr. Hinks, Toronto, to the effect that the "footnote" was not to hold people in bondage, but as a guidance to spiritual life.

In speaking to his motion Dr. Andrews said it was important to guard against the idea that Conference did not see any danger in these things, but the Methodist church must not attempt to dictate to its people.

Chancellor Burwash said that the reason this footnote had not been removed long ago was the fear that the people would think that the Church was taking backward ground on the questions. He thought it was a source of weakness to have rules that were not enforced.

Dr. Speer withdrew his amendment in favor of Dr. Andrews' substitute, which was then carried by a large majority, more than three-fourths of the members voting for it.

The famous footnote on amusements will, therefore, be removed from the Methodist Discipline and Dr. Andrews' substitute will take its place.

Rev. Mr. Haigh, British delegate, said goodbye to the Conference, and declared he had been greatly impressed with the richness and variety of the Canadian heritage. Missionaries to Japan and China were introduced to the Conference and made stirring addresses. The Conference rose and sang "Onward, Christian Soldiers."

The original "footnote" over which so many debates have arisen in the past is as follows: "The general rules are to be understood as forbidding neglect of duties of any kind, imprudent conduct, indulging in wilful tempers and words, the buying, selling or using of intoxicating liquors as beverages, dancing, playing games of chance, encouraging lotteries, attending theatres, horse races, circuses, dancing parties, patronizing dancing schools, taking such other amusements as are obviously of a misleading or questionable moral tendency, and all acts of disobedience to the order and discipline of the Church."
