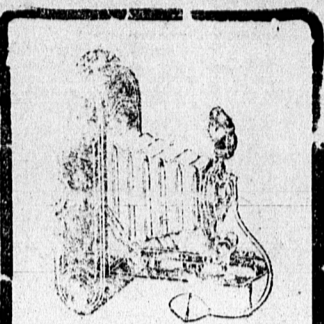

**GOOD LAYERS.**—At this time when eggs are at a premium, it will be of interest to state that the Maritime Orpington Farm, Park St., City, has a pen of nine Buff Orpington pullets, hatched May 17, that last week, (in 7 days) laid 48 eggs; most of them laying every day in the week. Two of the pullets have laid 16 days in succession, and all of them have been laying over a month and a half. This goes to show what can be done with poultry, when systematic breeding and proper mating of the best layers is carried out. The Buff Orpington is becoming a great favorite on the farm of late and a good many sales of these marvellous layers are reported as having taken place at the recent poultry show.

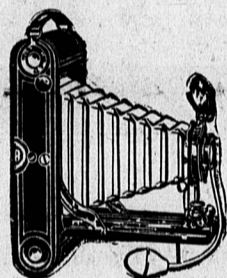
