## ENACTMENT OF WILD SCENE IN RUSSIAN DOUMA

### Drumhead Courts-Martial Called "Stolypin Necktie," Starts the Fuss--Premier Stared Wildly at His Insulter and Left the Chamber

St. Petersburg, Dec. 3.—"The Stolypin necktie," an expression used by Fedor I. Roditcheff, the orator of the Constitutional Democrats in the Duma, was reported to have caused the issuing of a challenge. The Associated Press learns that to the ministers with him, M. Stolypin firmly announced his decision to challenge M. Roditcheff to a duel and that he asked M. Chetchevlovitoff, the minister of justice, and Prince Vassilchikoff to act as his seconds. All efforts to dissuade the premier from this course were fruitless. The seconds, however, employing the utmost tact to forestall such an event, which would have shaken the entire government, approached M. Roditcheff and in delicate terms inquired what his intentions were towards the prime minister.

**BEGGED STOLYPIN'S FORGIVENESS**  
The tumult caused by M. Roditcheff's speech continued for half an hour during which the speaker was severely handled and finally carried away bodily by his supporters to a corner of the hall. The

party leaders then entered into a long consultation and it was made plain by the Constitutional Democrats that M. Roditcheff had meant no personal attack on the premier, but had been carried away by impetuosity. M. Roditcheff thereupon went to the pavilion and begged M. Stolypin's forgiveness.

After an hour's intermission, during which the passions of the members subsided, the session was re-opened.

The incident interrupted a speech of exceptional power and eloquence, M. Roditcheff making what is regarded as one of the greatest efforts of his life. His dashing espousal of the Polish cause and his argument proving that the earliest Russian political ideals were democratic and not autocratic is considered the most masterly exposition heard within the walls of the Duma.

## POPULATION OF LONDON MAY BE 16,000,000

### Experts Estimate that this Figure May be Reached in 1960

London Dec. 2.—The Metropolitan Water Board is engaged in trying to solve the great problem of London's water supply fifty years hence, when the population within its area will be more than doubled. As a step toward the solution of the problem the board is now erecting in various parts of London large storage reservoirs.

The experts of the Water Board calculate that by 1916 the population of London will be 8,000,000, and that by the year 1950 it will be 16,000,000.

Whence is to come the unpolluted water to supply that vast aggregation of human beings? That is the very serious question which it is necessary for the present authorities to answer for the sake of the coming generations.
