SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

LESSON VIII. FEBRUARY 25.

THE BAPTISM AND TEMPTATION OF JESUS.

Mark 1: 9-13; Matt. 4: 1-11.

GOLDEN TEXT.

"For in that He Himself hath suffered being tempted. He is able to succor them that are tempted."—Heb. 2: 18.

HOME READINGS.

By Rev. D. W. Snider.

The simple way in which we are of the Baptism of Jesus throws into more impressive relief the principle which He urged for the guidance of conduct: "It becomes us to fulfil all righteousness," or, "It is becoming for us to fulfil every ordinance." These things some think they can neglect without loss of harm, but Jesus teaches that none can afford to do it.

The appearance of the Spirit descending as a dove and the hearing of a commanding voice out of the heavens were for the enlightenment and comfort of both John and Jesus. The ministry of the one was fulfilled and the ministry of the Other was begun—and they both understood. And in one way or another God never leaves one who gives himself to Him in doubt as to his call and mission. But moments or days of exalted feeling and of the conscious desire of a total consecration quickly meet their period of strain and testing. This is the will of the Spirit and best for all concerned. What Jesus suffered and endured in the wilderness has proven of greater value to mankind than any shining procession of miracles of spectacular interest and power could possibly have done. Every poor, devil-tempted soul knows that is true.

Kempis says: "It is better to lie hid and take care of one's self than, neglecting one's self, to work even miracles." That the ministry of Jesus was not thrust full before the world from the moment of His baptism gives us evidence that the chosen Redeemer of men rather took the way of a well-tested instrument. He that was to bear the sins of many and make intercession for transgressors must first be proven, as the bridge whose every rod has been tried is tested by weighted succession of world forces upon His soul.

The devil is a master hand at wielding them and knows the hour and the spot at which to lay them. Forty days of wilderness, fasting and loneliness, with the mind and heart occupied with the plans of a kingdom over which He has been called to be King, while yet without court or following, but with a world carnally expectant, gives the adversary his opportunity. The devil took it (he never misses his opportunity). Jesus suffered it. But how did it end? The devil leaveth Him.

Whether Jesus could possibly have sinned or not is debatable according to the viewpoint one chooses to take. But the spot on which to stand is where all are agreed. It is this: Jesus had power not to sin, and He used it. Will not God give you that power also? He will.

It is well to give consideration to the nature of the temptations with which Jesus was put to the test. Appetite, ambition, even confidence in God are the points where the devil sought to insert his wedge and have out a responding lust. Where Jesus was tried let others be on guard.

But the method of Jesus in resisting temptation it is important to learn and to follow. He used the word of God. It has to be said that the devil makes use of it, too. There is all the more reason in that that the Scriptures be learned sufficiently well to know when it is used, as the devil did, in a false and lying way. Study the principles which are revealed in the answers of Jesus for it is possible to have a parrot memory of the words of scripture, and fall in the far reaching and soul-saving application of them.

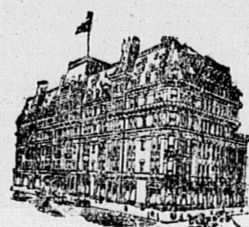
