Grooming and Stabling Horses.

The work horse should be groomed daily and well. The morning is an easier and more convenient time for the man, the night better for the horse. In the morning the horse is dry and can be easily groomed, and if the keeper gets up in season, so it can be done before breakfast, the morning wash cleans away every stable trace. The objection to leaving the groomed until morning is that the dried dust prevents or hinders respiration during the entire night and the horse, like the man, rests better when clean. It remains to be said, however, in favor of the morning grooming that it is usually more thoroughly done, as the horse is damp, especially in summer, until late in the night and cannot be well cleaned until entirely dry.

The horse should have a good bed of straw, which should be shaken up every morning and the droppings and wet straw thrown out. The floor under the horse should be kept dry by the use of gypsum, which also prevents loss of ammonia and does away with foul odor in the stable. The ammonia saved by the use of gypsum, or plaster, in the stables will pay for the latter, and you have the sweet, healthful air for a profit.

Ideal Shetland Pony.

The ideal Shetland should have round body and its legs be short and not buckled at the knees.

In buying a pony select one that has good knee action and holds his head well up. Always avoid one that has a sleepy appearance.

The original Shetland ponies come from the Shetland Isles, off the extreme north coast of Scotland. It is known that ponies have inhabited these islands for nearly 200 years, but the first ponies imported to this country were brought over about the middle of the last century.

Shetlands are of all colors, and color cuts no figure in judging their points. They are easy to raise and are always in good demand.

Feeding Lambs.

Accustom the lambs gradually to full feed. Corn and early cut clover are the best combination for finishing lambs. It is a balanced ration and is grown on almost every farm. Succulent food, as roots or silage, should be available and should be fed once a day. Food like this keeps the skin in good condition and gives the wool a better luster.

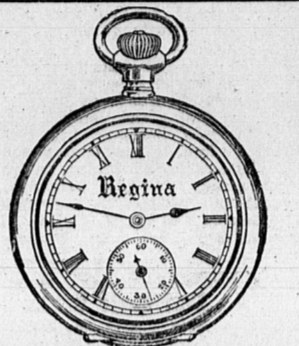
