The following letter is from Dan Stewart, grandson of Mr. Murdoch McKinnon, Forest Hill, to his former pastor, Rev. Wm. McLeod, Dundas, West Sandling, England.

April 12th, 1916.
Dear Pastor and Bro.
Received your welcome letter today. I was very much pleased to hear from you. I will read the verse of Scripture you have quoted. I always read a passage when I get time and I made a promise to my dear aunts before I left home to bend my knee in prayer to God and read some part of His word every day. So far I have kept my promise and will if I can. Perhaps there will be a time on the field of battle that we cannot get a chance to read the Scripture but we can always find time to pray. I was reading yes

terday in The Guardian a letter from my friend, Corporal McLaren of Forest Hill now in France. He states that if one is prepared to meet death he need not worry about the battle. I think this is as true a word as was ever spoken. Something that will sink deeply into ones mind. The army is a place where one meets with many temptations he would not meet in every day life and one finds it hard to keep straight but ridicule as some people may, I say ridicule will never hurt one. I know since joining the army last spring I have seen much of the effect of strong drink. I have this to say if some people had seen as much of its effects as I they would never touch the foul stuff again. I am glad to hear of the good work the recruiting meetings are doing. Men are needed and lots of them as we face a hard problem. Now dear brother I guess I will close as I have to write home. We shortly leave for France.
