### THE SUMMER SCHOOL OF SCIENCE.

Among the many institutions affording opportunities to teachers and students of all classes to improve themselves and at the same time to enjoy a holiday, none offer the same attractions as The Summer School of Science. "Interesting, educative and recreative," is the motto of the School. The ideas of the motto are effectively carried out in its working. Especially to the teacher who desires to keep pace with the advanced advancing thought in education, the School affords an alluring prospect. Meeting as it does in the holiday season, he can attend without interfering with his regular work.

The session will be held this year at North Sydney, July 3rd to 20th. As a place of meeting Sydney offers many advantages. Its scenery presents hill and valley, ocean lake and river in varied and interesting panorama, while the industries in the vicinity are an object lesson of great educational value. In the coal mine the dolomite quarry, the iron and copper deposits will be found opportunities for the study of geology and mineralogy that but few places afford.

Always an interesting feature of the School is the excursions. Historic Louisburg will be visited, The Marconi towers and the practical working of wireless telegraphy will be accessible to the School. This year the excursions will be of more than usual interest, taking in the Dominion Steel Company, Glace Bay and Sydney Mines, the old French town of Louisburg, the Bras d'Or Lakes and the dolomite works.

While the tuition fees at other summer schools are so high that many are deterred from attending, the School for the Atlantic Provinces has fixed its rates and expenses at so small a figure that its manifold advantages are practically within the reach of all. The advantages to a teacher from attending the School are so obvious that all who can do so should make it a point to enrol themselves.

Full information in regard to this excellent institution may be obtained by communicating with the President J. D. Seaman of this city, or the Secretary, W. R. Campbell of Truro, N. S. All teachers attending the School will be allowed by the Board of Education an additional two weeks' holidays provided their school trustees consent, which they ought to do in all cases.

### COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS.

Prof. Edward L. Thorndike of Columbia University after careful study of the question is in great doubt about the utility of college entrance examinations. In the first place it taxes the energy of both teachers and students considerably in their specific preparation for these examinations, and involves some worry by students and parents before and after and by college admission boards in giving, scoring and recording the results.

Prof. Thorndike finds that the result of an entrance examination is but a very indifferent test of the probable progress and standing of a student in college work "If, knowing that fifty individuals ranked in the order Jones, Smith, Brown, &c in their entrance marks, one were to wager that in college work of, say, the junior year they would rank Jones, Smith, Brown, etc., as before, he would lose his bet in forty-seven cases out of fifty." MONTREAL, June 23.—Ontario papers are commenting on the disappearance of the potato bug.
