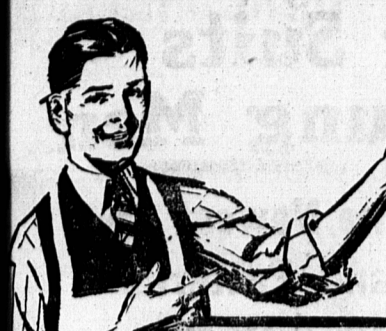

MAIL FOR OVERSEAS - A full mail for Great Britain and other countries via Great Britain will be forwarded by the steamer Megantic from Montreal on Saturday, the 22nd. Correspondence specially addressed to the New York route will connect with the S. S. Aquitania sailing from New York on Tuesday, the 25th at midnight. A full mail for Great Britain will be despatched by the Empress of Scotland, sailing from Quebec on Wednesday, the 26th, and another full mail for Great Britain will be forwarded by the Montrose from Montreal on Friday, the 28th, and another mail by the steamer Doric also from Montreal on Saturday, the 29th.

Cook of the Miners Federation, today in speaking on the government's proposals which come before a miners national delegates conference here tomorrow. The miners, he asserted, would not agree to any alteration of hours or wages. A full meeting of the miners executive committee was held today to consider the Government's proposals and is understood to have prepared recommendations to be made to the delegates conference.
