**Upward Trend**

**In Paper Stocks**

**At Montreal**

MONTREAL, Oct. 1—(CP)—A pronounced upward trend was distinguishable among papers in active trading on the stock exchange and curb market today. Other industrial groups were comparatively quiet. Mines were about mixed in moderately active trading.

Closing averages indicated banks off .05 to .2663; utilities off 3 to .765; industrials up 9 to 119.9; papers up 115 to 364.59 and gold off 43 to 79.62. Volume was 50,500 industrial shares and 183,300 mining shares.

Brown, Abitibi and Donnasona were among the most active members of the paper section adding 3-8 on a turnover of 2,885 shares respectively. Consolidated, the most active paper closed unchanged at 19 trading 5,474 shares. Fraser went up a point at 52 and Price 5-8 at 64 1-8. Up 1-4 were Great Lakes at 18 3-4, M and O. at 22 1-2. St. Lawrence Corp., "C" Pfd. at 48 1-4 and Bathurst at 22 1-4. Abitibi Pfd., with a turnover of 1,885 shares added 3-8 at 20 1-2. Sole loser among the more active papers was International off 1-2 at 58 1-4.

O'Brien was active in mines today and the Good added 13 cents to close at 240. Beaulieu and Sherritt-Gordon dropped 5 cents at 43 and 300 respectively. Ahead 100 were Louvicourt up 4 cents, Eldona 4, Santiago 1, Vinray 1-2. Quebec Manganese 1-2, Central Cadillac 1-2 and Alger 1-4. Off were Centremare 4, Cortez 3, Cheskir 1 and Ashley 1. Heaviest individual trader was Beatrice ahead 2 7-8 cents with a turnover of 43,500 shares.

Other industrial gainers included C. and D. Sugar up 5-8 at 21 1-8. Industrial Alcohol "A" 1-4 at 14 3-4. Canada Cement 1-4 at 19 3-4. International Nickel 1-4 at 33 and C.P.R. 1-4 at 14 1-4. Canadian Breweries Rights were heavily traded in alcohol and increased 1-2 cent. Gaspe added two cents in oils and Homestead was shaded. Ottawa Car dropped 3-4 at 7 3-4 and Royal Bank 1-8 at 22 1-2.
