Ship Bound From Saint John Sunk Off Portland, Eng.

WEYMOUTH, Dorsetshire, England, July 4. (CP Cable) - The 1,000 ton cargo ship Mercant Royal, bound from Saint John, N. B. to Hull carrying a British clergyman, his wife and two young sons, sank off Portland, Dorsetshire, last night, following an early morning collision with the British United States ship, William B. Travis.

No loss of life was reported. Rev. J. Gordon Astle, vicar of the Baptist Church at Gull Lake, Sask., his wife and two young sons, Kenny, were the only passengers. They were taken off several hours after the collision and suffered no ill effects. "All my furniture, linen - everything on board for me to set up a fresh home in England - was lost," said Astle.

The ship was loaded with lumber and there was little chance of its sinking immediately but with some of the crew several hours before the Captain put us in a motor boat. At the time things did not appear too certain. We were picked up two hours later by the destroyer H. M. S. "Savage". The William B. Travis, a merchant ship enroute to Philadelphia was reported slightly damaged.

Provincial Rights Stressed in Senate

OTTAWA, July 4. (CP) - Senator William Aestline, acting Progressive Conservative leader, urged in the Senate yesterday that amendments be heard before the Federal Government's redistribution resolution is passed.

By a major amendment the resolution would swell the number of members of the Committee on the Redistribution of Provincial Rights. He suggested that representatives of those governments be allowed to place their views before a sub-committee on the bill. He also urged, as an alternative, that it should be a subject of discussion at the Dominion-Provincial Conference.

She insisted that an intelligent man wanted an intelligent woman as a companion, whether it be a night club or in the home, be she blonde or not.

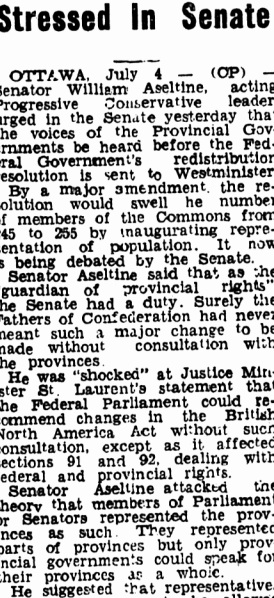
"The over-dressed female, be it a blonde or a brunette, is an inch of her life, just doesn't get by," she said.

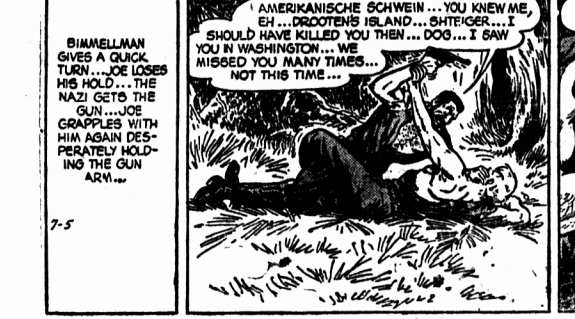

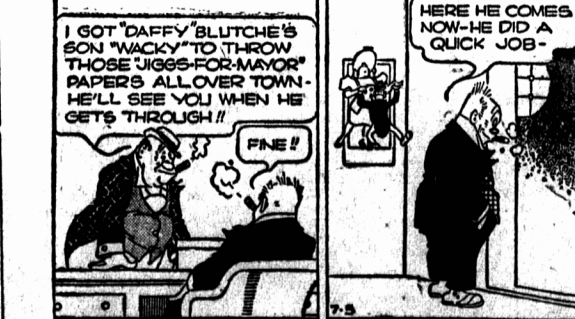
