MONTREAL, June 11—(CP)—
Gains ranging from fractions to a
point or more featured an upward
bound stock market at the close
today.

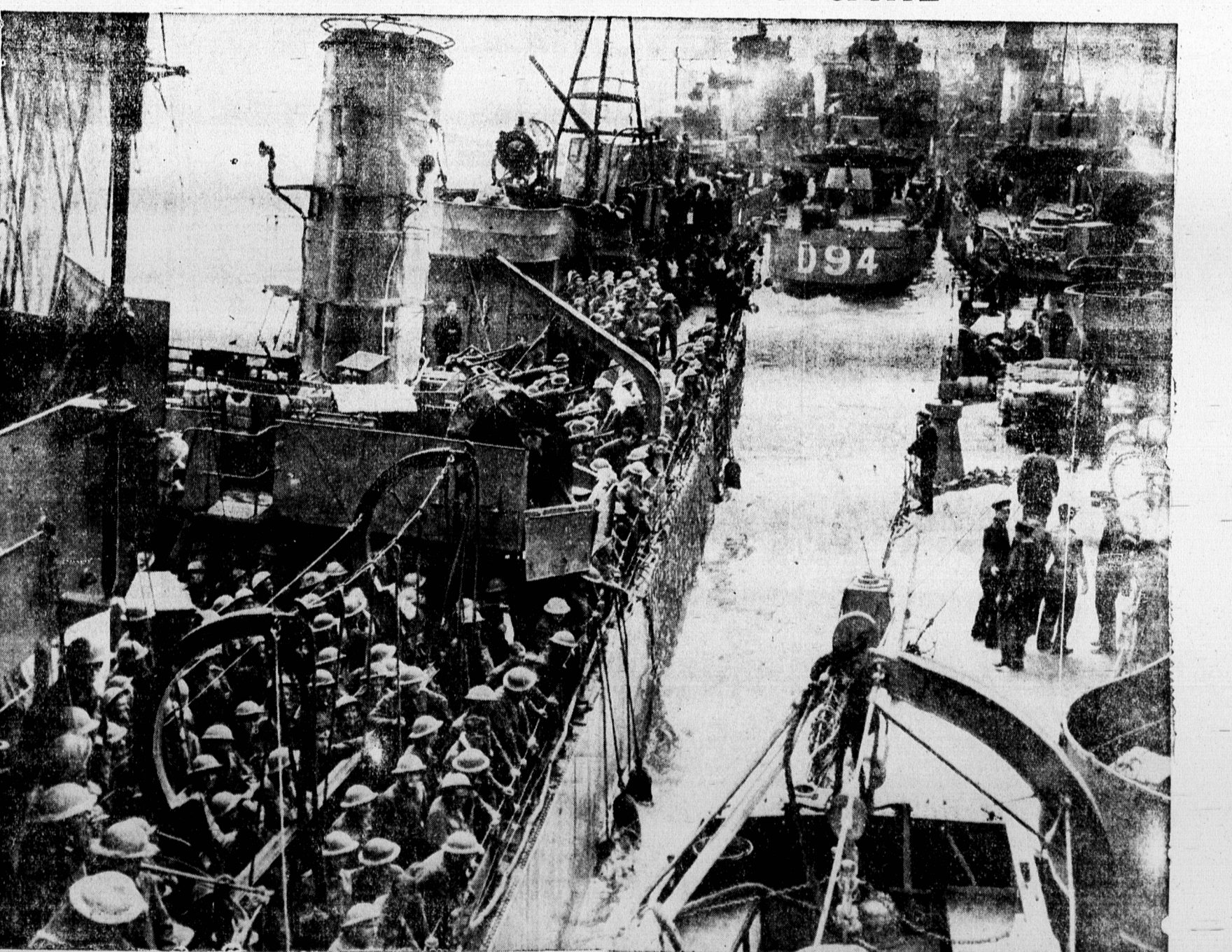
NEW YORK, June 11—(AP)—
Domestic business prospects over-
shadowed cloudy war news in to-
day's stock market and leading
issues rallied 1 to more than 5
points.

The Associated Press average of
60 stocks came back for a net ad-
vance of 1.4 points at 38.4, wider
upturn for a single session since
Oct. 17, last year. The composite
was off 1.2 points Monday. Trans-
fers amounted to 79,800 shares
compared with 97,440 the day
before.

Prominent share gainers includ-
ed U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, General
Motors, Douglas Aircraft, Sperry,
Westinghouse, Anaconda, Kenn-
cott, Standard Oil of N. J., Dow
Chemical, Allied Chemical, Ameri-
can Can, International Harvester,
