ANARCHISTS WRECK A TRAIN

Thought Russian Grand Duke Was on Board—Berlines Victims.

BERLIN, Sept. 9.—A railway express train disaster which is supposed to have been caused by anarchists occurred yesterday twenty miles from Berlin. No lives were lost but six persons were injured and the greater part of the train was destroyed by a fire which broke out in the wreck. The train, which was on its way to Berlin from Eydtkuhnen, the station on the Russian frontier, left the track near Strassburg. An examination showed that the bolts that held the rails had been loosened for a distance of thirty yards.

NEW TREATMENT FOR CANCER.

Hungarian Doctor Succeeds in Thirty-Seven Cases Out of Forty.

BUDAPEST, Sept. 9.—Dr. Haler, an eminent local physician asserts that he has secured beneficial results in cancer cases at the University Hospital through the use of an injection of gelatine. In forty cases thus treated he was unsuccessful in only three.

IRISH AFFAIRS ARE TROUBLOUS

Constabulary Cannot be Trusted Since the Recent Agitation.

DUBLIN, Sept. 9.—That the Government is apprehensive with regard to the coming winter in Ireland, and is doubtful regarding the loyalty of the constabulary since the Belfast agitation, is revealed in the present strong efforts to recruit the force. The number of the constabulary has been steadily decreasing for the past four years. The authorities have set aside a part of the Dublin military barracks as additional quarters for the men, and to the constables and officers throughout the country there has been sent a circular instructing them to secure suitable candidates.

PUTS BAN ON SKYSCRAPERS

New York's Tall Buildings Denounced by Fire Underwriters and Others.

NEW YORK, Sept. 9.—Opposition to the building of skyscrapers was voiced vigorously at a public hearing before the committee on limitation of height and area of building code revision commission yesterday. George W. Babl, President of the New York board of fire underwriters, said his board was expecting a fire of unprecedented size at any time in the high buildings. He said it was the belief of the fire underwriters that if a fire started on the upper floors of some of the highest buildings, it could not be checked as the water pressure is insufficient, and he feared it would spread to many other high buildings entailing an enormous loss.

ROOSEVELT AND THE PHILIPPINES

Regeneration of The Islands as a Task for the President.

LONDON, Sept. 9.—That Theodore Roosevelt should undertake the job of regenerating the Philippines after the completion of his presidential term is suggested by the Spectator. "Why should not Mr. Roosevelt be asked to undertake the vastly possible and honorable task," the paper asks. "In a little more than a year he will be free and in a little more than two years he will be re-elected and have the heart for any fate. Could he devote his powers to a work of wider import. At all events until some solution as heroic as that has been attempted, we, as ardent well wishers of America, should not reconcile ourselves to the sale of the Philippines."

DARING ROBBERS MAKE ESCAPE

OMAHA, Neb., Sept. 9.—Three men who had picked the pockets of a number of Rock Island passengers at the station in Lincoln and attempted to continue their thieving on the train, fought with Conductor Henry Duval on the Rocky Mountain Limited train near Alvos station early today. After standing off the conductor with a knife, the men leaped from the moving train and escaped.
