EAST PRINCE.

The elevation of Hon John Yeo to the Senate makes vacant the Commons seat for East Prince and a by-election in that riding will shortly be in order. The constituency is an important one, having within its bounds the western capital of the Island with other populous business centres, and also two of the terminals of our lines of communication with the main land.

There are our fishery and agricultural interests to be considered, our claims against the federal government to be looked after, and last, but not least, there is the great question of prohibition, now in an extremely critical stage, and needing the best support that can be obtained for it in the councils of the country.

At a by-election mere questions of party may well be relegated to the back ground. The Laurier government is no doubt seated firmly enough to hold on at least till another general election comes round, and a matter of one more or less in the ministerial majority is of itself of small moment.

What seems to be desirable in East Prince at the present time is that both parties shall put in the field men of ability and character who will be independent enough to stand against their leaders, if needs be, in the true interests of the country.

We have no official knowledge as to the intentions of the respective parties, but it has been expected that the Liberals of the riding may nominate Mr. J. H. Bell. They could hardly do better, in view of his straight record in matters of temperance legislation, his ability and the measure of independence shown by him while in the provincial legislature.
