THE GUARDIAN'S TROPHIES.

In years of effort for the moral and material betterment of our City and Province there are some things that have been achieved within a few years past of which The Guardian is proud.

One of these has to do with the health, comfort and convenience of our citizens in the reduction of the sewerage system. Another is the present Prohibitory Law, completing the work of entirely legalizing the liquor traffic throughout the Island.

Another is the second winter steamer, the Minto, supplying a most pressing want in our communications with the mainland.

Still another is the Soldier's Monument, the only public memorial of the kind in our city and Province and one of the finest in Canada.

And finally there is the improved telegraph service, recently introduced. Of all these improvements The Guardian was the earnest and strenuous advocate.

We speak of these things in no boastful spirit and with no desire to appropriate more credit for the results achieved than is our due. Scores and hundreds of others have been working in the same fields and for the same objects, and The Guardian is proud to have been a co-worker with them.

It is now claimed that the Russian forces are superior in numbers to the Japanese, but we anticipate nothing worse than a drawn battle if the Japanese do not win the victory at Yantai.
