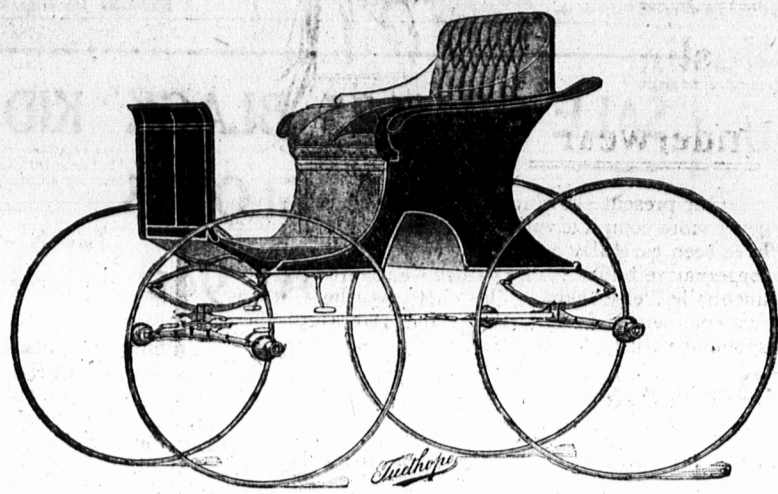


Tudhope and Heney Carriages and Harness



(No. 74—Corning Stanhope, Pneumatic or Cushion Tires).

Body—24x51 on bottom, wide, roomy seat, high spring back and spring cushion, velvet carpet. Rear of body is closed in. Special dash braces.

Trimming—20-oz. green wool cloth, No. 1 handbuffed leather, or whipcord, upholstered side panels. Dash and lamps as shown. Specially trimmed shafts. Axles 7-8-in., quick arch, oval pattern ball-bearing. Solid forged shaft couplings, reach heels and stay ends, open-head springs, wooden spring bars. Quick shifters. Wire wheel 34-in. front and rear with 1 3/4-in. detachable pneumatic tires, or Sarven wheels, with ball-bearings and 1 1/4 cushion tire.
