RAILROAD RECORDS

There is the greatest rivalry between some of the British roads as regards the speed at which they operate their trains, and there is also keen competition as to which road can make the longest run without a stop says the Boston Herald in an article on fast transportation.

According to the report received, there are seven water tanks that can be used by a moving locomotive between London and Holyhead, but to furnish sufficient coal for such runs engine tenders will have to be made larger.
