A visit to the greenhouse of James Galt, Jr, Brighton, would amply repay one in search of an appropriate Christmas gift for almost any of one's friends. No one ever thought of a Christmas without flowers, and it is certain that in choosing flowers as gifts one experiences no little amount of pleasure; and after a choice has been made from the many different varieties the gratification of the intended recipient is assured. Mr Galt has almost everything in Christmas plants. Of course the weather in the past few weeks has been such as to prevent the blooming of one variety but the exceptional beauty of the others makes up for the loss of a single variety. In flowering plants one may choose from the Chinese Primrose, Roman Hyacinth, Narcissus or the Primula Obconica, all of which are leaders in beauty and fragrance. Of Ornamental Foliage Plants there are Boston Ferns, Palms, Palms, Rubber Plants, Araucarias, and the ever popular Jerusalem Cereus. These latter have proved very taking in this city and already a very large number have been disposed of. Among the cut flowers he has roses, Carnations, Roman Hyacinth, araucarius. The supply of carnations is limited owing to the lack of sun to ripen the buds. A very nice little plant is the Japanese Air Plant, luxuriant and self-reliant, and requiring absolutely no attention. Also in foliage plants are two prominent leaders, Asparagus and Plumroses, both great favorites. Any of the varieties mentioned are appropriate, lasting and seasonable gifts and under the careful supervision of one experienced in the cultivation of all kinds of plants and flowers are sure to be strong, healthy and blooming reminders of the giver.
