Great Interest Over Premier's Statements

GENOA, April 28.—The British Prime Minister's address to the British and United States press representatives yesterday created a great deal of interest here, and the official stenographic copy of it was issued yesterday afternoon. It was understood before the address that Premier Lloyd George was not to be quoted, but when he had concluded he remarked: "After all, you can quote me if you wish, it is better that my thoughts be published."


Among the significant statements voiced by the Prime Minister were the following: "You have Germany and Russia who are in a condition of semi-antagonism to the rest of Europe. There is a state suspended and barely suspended conflict. That means two-thirds of Europe and anybody who imagines you can permanently, by any combination, keep down two great peoples representing two-thirds of Europe, must be either blind or blinkered." "It is an impossibility; it is folly; it is insanity. You must arrive at an understanding in which will be included the whole of these peoples." After warning of the danger to Hungary by Russia being equipped by an angry Germany, the Premier asked: "How long will it be before Europe is devastated if that represents the permanent policy of any combination in Europe?"

The document of Powers will be handed to the Russian delegates to be considered today by Premier Lloyd George, Schanzler, Barthou, Jaspard and Baron Hayashi, at Premier Lloyd George's villa. It will be submitted to the sub-committee on Russian Affairs tomorrow.

Extract Bullet From Lenine

RIGA, April 27.—Premier Lenine, of Soviet Russia, was operated on yesterday, says a report from Moscow today. A bullet, which had troubled him for three years, was extracted from his side. Last accounts were that the patient was doing well.
