

### Country-wide Strike Of Printers In Italy

ROME, March 22 — (Monday) — A country-wide printers strike started at midnight forcing all of Italy's daily newspapers to shut down.

The big Communist-directed Union of Typographers ordered Government and newspaper printers off their jobs for at least 24 hours.

The strike was called in support of demands by printers in small private shops for a 34-per-cent wage increase.

An estimated 1,000 daily newspapers were affected. Ansa, Italy's largest news agency, also was struck.

### Says Princess Elizabeth Expects Baby In October

LONDON, March 21 — (AP) — The People, a London Sunday paper, said today that Princess Elizabeth is expected to have a baby in October.

The story drew an official "no comment" from Buckingham Palace sources. It is the first time a British newspaper has come out with a definite statement as to the Princess' pregnancy. The Sunday Pictorial said two months ago that Princess Elizabeth and Prince Philip confided to intimates they would like a baby in the first year of their marriage.
