CHICAGO, Dec. 5 — (AP) — Grains rallied today in the face of another sharp decline on May rice futures.

NEW YORK, Dec. 5 — (AP) — Advances of 1 to 8 points to new yearly highs in aircrafts and rail equipment stimulated a last-hour rally in today's Stock Market and erased or sizably reduced earlier extreme lows in a good number of issues.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite rose 1.1 of a point to 72.2.

MONTREAL, Dec. 5 — (CP) — Industrials and papers went to new eight-year highs and utilities to a fresh five-year peak in the indices in transactions today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market. Industrial increases ranged from fractional to 5 points for the "Blue Chips".

Number of issues boarded was the largest for many years, management of the marts reported.

TORONTO, Dec. 5 — (CP) — Gold stocks firmed moderately on the Toronto Exchange today and minor losses were netted by the Base Metal and Western Oil group. Trading was comparatively quiet in the Base Metal on small losses for Smelters, Ventur, Falconbridge and Quebec Manitou. Nickel and Noranda advanced.
