CANADIAN NORTHERN BEGINS STEAMSHIP SERVICE MAY 15.

TORONTO, March 8-D. D. Mann, vice-president of the C. N. R., says that a cable has been received from D. B. Hanna, third vice-president, who in Britain, stating arrangements have been completed for the C. N. R. trans-Atlantic passenger service. The British terminus will be at Bristol or Avonmouth. Two passenger steamers have been purchased, the Cairo and the Helopolis, and will be named the Royal George and Royal Edward, royal permission having been obtained. The service will be inaugurated on May 15 from England.

Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may home-stead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of the intending homesteader.
