Lively Discussion On Oyster Leasing Policy In The House Of Commons

Great Future Seen By Hon. E.N. Rhodes For Island Oyster Fishery Under Proper Supervision. Criticism Of Mr. A. E. MacLean Replied To By Government Members And Supporters.

A lengthy debate on the oyster leasing policy of the Dominion Government took place in the House of Commons, Ottawa, on the 19th inst. The committee discussion of an item of \$80,000 in the Estimates for oyster culture...

Mr. MacLean: "I wish to thank the minister for the information. I should like now to get from him information as to the receipts which have come in from the operation of the oyster industry..."

Result at Bideford River Hon. Mr. DURANLEAU: "I am afraid some time would be required to give exact information as to the amount of money received from the sale of oysters..."

Methods of Culture Mr. VENIOT: "Would the minister tell me whether in the policy adopted by the government in connection with the cultivation of oysters empty shells are used..."

Leases Granted Hon. Mr. DURANLEAU: "The number of leases issued last year was forty for Prince county and nine for Queens county..."

Tenders Called In Each Case Hon. Mr. DURANLEAU: "We asked for tenders in every case in which we sold oysters..."

Same Policy Pursued Hon. Mr. DURANLEAU: "I can give information about the number of acres under lease at the present time, at \$1 per acre..."

department. The fishing industry is of sufficient importance to receive more attention from the government...

Mr. MacLean: "I appreciate the remarks of the Minister of Finance (Mr. Rhodes)..."

Mr. Rhodes: "Because it was overfished. They brought these oysters in because the area had been overfished..."

Mr. Rhodes (Minister of Finance): "If my colleague will permit me to say a word, I think perhaps what the acting minister has in mind is that the policy which now obtains..."

Mr. MacLean: "I cannot say that I agree with that. Dr. Neidler is making a remarkable study, and although the fishermen may not think he is making progress..."

Mr. MacLean: "I want to point out at the present time that if the sum of \$8,000 was spent there, the minister must have received in rent some \$3,000 or \$4,000..."

Mr. MacLean: "I have not the exact figures before me. The leases are not all the same; some are for five acres, others for three, and I think the hon. member knows enough about the matter to know if the oysters were sold by tender..."
