Practical Fashion Hints



No. 7824 is a blouse design which may be cut and finished in an hour or two. It is suitable for silk, linen or a light wool material and may be trimmed with stitching or have the collar and cuffs of a contrasting material. If the waist is developed in a dark silk, it is also effective to close it with a line of novelty buttons in pretty colorings.

There are several ways of finishing the bottom of separate waists; the most approved method is the shaped peplum of the material of muslin. If the pattern does not allow for this peplum, one may be made by cutting from a fold of muslin or silk, a semi-circular piece about half the width of the waist line and about 3 inches wide; try on the waist, arrange the fulness to your satisfaction, adjust the peplum and cut away the extra material from underneath.

This is a simple design, close-fitting, with a button on the side; has an elbow length sleeve and a separate gimp.

Size 36 requires in this design, 2 1/2 yards of 36 inch material. The pattern includes 5 sizes; 34 to 42.

He is also desirous to keep out of touch with the United States.
