and the windows are the same. One woman told me that the water on the table would freeze with a fire in the stove, and the heat they have from that stove is probably the only heat they have in the house.

Only a few weeks ago one of our patients died. The family had kept everything spotless and the first thing they asked me after the girl had passed away was, could they have the house fumigated right off and asked for disinfectants to wash up clothing, etc.

Again, the other day a woman came to the Dispensary apparently fully dressed, but she seemed very backward in telling me what she wanted. After asking her a few questions I found out that her husband was laid up with tuberculosis.

At Christmas time we gave out toys, fruit and candy to one hundred and twenty-six children and orders of groceries to sixty-three homes. I feel that the clergy and doctors will endorse all that I am saying in connection with our work.

The Dispensary feels very grateful to many of the citizens for their generous contributions to the Coal Fund and for their help at Christmas time and also for the way they have supported the Dispensary by the envelope last year.

This report was received with applause and was followed by the reading of the report of the Sec'y which showed the total amount received to be \$1507.67; expenditure \$1330.25, leaving a balance of \$177.42.
