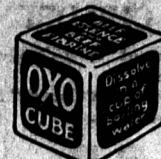

ALL OVER EUROPE

PARIS, Nov. 28 (Special)—At a meeting of the Academy of Incriptions on Wednesday Count Bogouen, the investigator of prehistoric remains, made a remarkable communication regarding the discovery of bison modeled in clay which he had discovered on October 10 in the cave known as the Tus Dithaubert, in the district of Montegouien (Ariège). It was in the same cave that Count Bogouen discovered prehistoric pictures of animals on the walls, a discovery which was reported to the Academy by M. Salomon Reinach last August. Count Bogouen related on Wednesday that when further exploring the cave with his sons on October 10 he had found his progress barred by a mass of stalactites. A hole was broken through the obstacle and the explorers passed into a gallery in which they discovered two figures, respectively 26in. and 30in. long, representing a male and female bison. The figures were almost intact, although slightly cracked by the drying of the clay. They appeared to have been attached to the wall of the cave, or, rather, to some rocks which had fallen from the roof. The only damage that they received was that one of the horns of the female bison and its tail had been broken off. The tail was found on the floor of the cave. The figures have the aspect of wax-relief, as only the right side was completely modeled, while the side that was sticking to the rock was scarcely formed. Count Bogouen found a third small clay figure, but it was so roughly modeled as to make it impossible to say what it represents. In passing through the vast galleries of the cave the explorers found many footprints of bears and also a number of human footprints. In one of the galleries, where there was an otherwise indistinguishable number of marks on the floor, some 50 imprints of human heels were discovered, and Count Bogouen suggested that these may represent traces of ritual observances or dances similar to those which have been observed among the savage tribes of the present day in Australia and Africa. Count Bogouen's find is said to be the first discovery of prehistoric clay figures which has been recorded, and the conjectures which were made in the Academy as to their antiquity ranged as far as 20,000 years ago.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a household or any male over 16 years of age may homestead a quarter section of a valuable Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties.—Six months' residence upon the land or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead rights and cannot obtain pre-emption, may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$200 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$500.00. Deputy of the Minister of the Interior A. L. 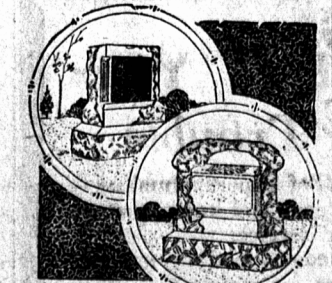
