IN CASE OF DOUBT SALUTE ANY GERMAN

Is Order to Belgian People by Prussian Conqueror.

LONDON, Sept. 28.—The official Press Bureau has made public a copy of a proclamation said to have been issued by Major Dieckmann, commanding the general forces of the Germans in the commune of Orveigne, a suburb of Liege.

The proclamation ordered all inhabitants to give up all arms or explosives, saying, "whoever does not do this will be liable to the penalty of death; he will be shot immediately or otherwise executed unless he can prove he is not to blame."

The inhabitants of the commune are ordered to be indoors at nightfall and to keep their doors shut. "Resistance to orders," the proclamation says, "entails a penalty of death."
