OUR IMMIGRATION IS DECLINING

OTTAWA, September 30.--The total immigration into Canada from the first of January until the end of August was 117,563, as compared with 215,772 for the same period of last year. A decrease of 46 per cent. Immigration at ocean ports was 76,569, as compared with 133,816 showing a decrease of 99.247 for the eight months. From the United States the immigration was 40,964 as compared with 40,356 for the same period of last year, an increase of 8 persons. From the first of the fiscal year (April first) until the end of August 342 immigrants were refused admission into Canada at ocean ports and 1,266 were refused admission into Canada from the United States for the same period.

WARM POLITICS IN CUBA.

HAVANA, September 30.--Political disturbances have begun to assume some gravity in Cuba. A Conservative meeting at Sancti Spiritus, in Santa Clara province, was the occasion of a riot today, and in which many were injured, and in which the new Negro party, headed by General Estenoz, has broken up by Liberals, who kept up a continuous shouting. The mayor of the town and the police are members of the Liberal party. General Mario Manocal, a former Liberal, but recently nominated by the Conservatives for the presidency, arrived here this morning on a special train, accompanied by a large number of followers. Thousands of men met the Conservative leaders. The police approached General Manocal and demanded that he give up a pistol which he was presumed to carry. As he had a license to carry a pistol, which he showed, he refused to be searched, and, after the procession to the hall had formed, it was made the object of attacks on all sides.

PRINCE COUNTY NOMINATES MAN

Large and Enthusiastic Meeting Nominates A. A. Lefurgey.

(Special by phone.) SUMMERSIDE, October 1.--The Conservative Convention held at Summerside yesterday for the purpose of nominating a candidate to contest the district of Prince in the Federal Election was largely attended, every pole being fully represented. Only two delegates out of the total number not answering to their names at roll call.

Dr. Murphy, President of the west Prince Liberal Conservative Association, occupied the chair and in a short address explained to the meeting the purpose for which it was calling. Edward Hackett ex M. P., in a short address placed before the convention the name of A. A. Lefurgey. This nomination was seconded and carried by a unanimous standing vote. A committee of five was then appointed to wait upon Mr. Lefurgey and tender the unanimous nomination. The committee retired and in a few minutes returned in company with Mr. Lefurgey, who upon entering the hall was given a hearty reception. Mr. Lefurgey in a short address during which he dwelt upon the different subjects of interest both provincial and federal, accepted the nomination and closed his address by urging upon his supporters to enter the fight with clean hands, pledging himself to run a clean election. J. A. Mathieson, leader of the Provincial opposition was then called upon and in a short address laid before the meeting the platform of the conservative party on which they asked the support of the electors of Prince Edward Island in the coming election.

CIVIL SERVANTS MUST PAY TAXES

OTTAWA, September 10.--The department of trade and commerce was notified today that the commonwealth salaries act passed by the parliament of Australia has received the governor-general's assent. By this salaries and allowances paid by the commonwealth are liable to taxation by the states. The tax is payable in the state in which the officers resides and the salary is earned, and in the case of a member of parliament of the commonwealth in the state in which he was elected. The only exemption from taxation is the salary of the governor-general. The act was the outcome of considerable litigation, brought about by the refusal of persons in receipt of federal salaries and allowance to pay the income tax in respect thereof.

OVER HUNDRED MILES OF FLAME

OTTAWA, Sept. 30.--Forest and bush fires are raging in the far north of Canada. Inspector Jarvis, who is in charge of the Northwest Mounted Police at Fort Macpherson, located at the mouth of the Mackenzie River and on the shore of the Arctic Ocean reports to Comptroller White that from Two Islands to Fort Providence, a distance of a hundred and twenty-five miles along the shore of the Mackenzie River there is a solid mass of flame. He attributes the fire to the carelessness of the natives and recommends that the Government take measure to enforce the regulations to prevent fires. The loss of timber, he says, will be very heavy.

CARDINAL DEL VAL MAY SOON RESIGN

ROME, Sept. 30.--According to the Avanti, Cardinal Merry Del Val, the Papal Secretary of State, is about to retire. This step is an outcome of the representations made to the Vatican by American and British prelates, out particular Cardinal Gibbons and Bishop Ireland, who objected to the Secretary's severe message against modernism. Merry Del Val probably will be succeeded by Cardinal Rampolla, who formerly held this office. Rampolla's return to power will mean a policy of dignified conciliation with relation to France and an attitude of greater reserve toward Italy.

TORONTO, September 30.--Dr. Alfred Gandier of St. James' Presbyterian church, Toronto, a brother-in-law of President Falconer, of Toronto University, has been offered the principality of Knox College.
