Eggs: graded shipments in use free cases, selling price, A—large 47-48; A—medium 42-43; A—pullets 35-37; large original 33 1-2-29 3-27-27 1-2; C 1.

MONTREAL, Nov. 12.—(CP)—Sizable fractional declines throughout the list left the stock market on the downside at the close today.

Hudson Bay closed off 1-2. Noranda and Nickel 1-4 each while International Petroleum 7-8. Bell Telephone climbed 1-2 in utilities but losses of similar amounts were suffered by Shawinigan and International Power preferred while Gattineau eased 1-4.

C.P.R. and Canadian Car preferred were resistant as they posted gains of 1-2 and 3-8. Doseco, Ottawa Car and Canadian Car common finished 1-2 point easier. Howard Smith chafed up a gain of 1-12 but Price sold down a similar amount while Bathurst and St. Lawrence Corporation retreated narrowly.

Steel of Canada advanced 3-4 and Canada Cement 1-8. Seagrams rose 1 7-8 and Canada Steamships preferred and National Breweries 1-2 but Celanese sold off a point and Wabasco, Wilsis, Dominion Textile, Ogdive and Dominion Tar finished fractionally lower.

Total sales, 60,500 shares; Industrials, 47,300; Mines, 12,900; Bonds, \$2,500.
