Contract Bridge

THE FORCING PASS
Whether a player is aggressive or conservative, he cannot well afford to ignore these messages from partner which say, in effect, "Do something!" In short, a player cannot afford to act (or fail to act) as North did in the following case:
South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.
♠ 8 5
♥ 9 4 3
♦ 8 6 2
♣ J 6 4 3
N W E S
♠ 10 7 5 4
♥ K 10 9 8
♦ A K 10 9 7
♣ A Q J
The bidding:
South West North East
1 ♠ Pass Pass 3 ♠
3 ♠ Pass Pass 4 ♠
Pass Pass Pass (1)

When North passed and closed the bidding, South let out a belch that could be heard at quite a distance. This, of course, was inexcusable on South's part, since a belch is supposed to be played without facial or verbal histrionics, but we won't deny that South was a sorely tried player! Four hearts went down three tricks, but this was fairly cheap for East-West inasmuch as East had 100 honors. North, pointing to the fact that South could not have made even three spades against the best defense, said that he couldn't understand South's attitude—surely, a net profit of 200 points was better than going down at their own contract.
This gentle philosophy was not soothing to South! He pointed out in no uncertain terms that his pass over four hearts was absolutely forcing, demanding that North either double four hearts, or if he preferred, that he bid four spades. Since North had held nothing for spades and did have some defense against hearts, his decision (South said) was ready-made for him.
South's view, if not his "attitude", was correct! The forcing pass situation was implicit in all the bids that had and had not been made, and North should not simply have refused to "open his mouth."
