MONTREAL, May 11.—In the will of the late Robert Reford, \$250,000 was left to the Permanent Endowment Fund of the Diocese of Montreal, on condition that another quarter of a million dollars should be raised within a reasonable time, to be named by his executors. The latter have named January 1st, 1914, as the date, and the sum of \$55,000 remains to be raised to fulfill the conditions of the will. An appeal to church people to subscribe to the fund is being made.
