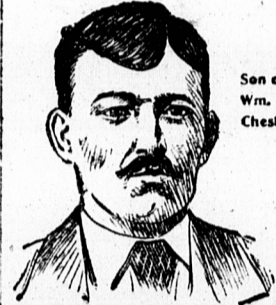

At Charlottetown, and within St. James' Hall there, on Tuesday, Nov. 3rd, 1908, and at ten o'clock a.m., the Presbytery of Prince Edward Island met in quarterly session and was constituted with prayer.

the question of union, presented their report, which was received and ordered to be engrossed in the minutes book.

The treasurer was authorized to pay the travelling expenses of the Union Committee out of the Presbytery fund. Messrs. John Hawley and A. Craise reported on their work at Falconwood and the P. E. Island Hospital, respectively.

Whereas it has been the practice of the Church since Reformation days to devote communion collections to the relief of the poor, Presbytery directs that these collections remain in the hands of the Session, and that the balance, after paying necessary expenses, be used for such benevolent purposes, or be devoted to the schemes of the Church.

Messrs. W. H. Spencer, Convener; John Hawley, T. F. Fullerton, Geo. E. Ross and T. C. James, were appointed a committee to consider that report on matters to which the attention of a Presbytery is directed, as on page four of Assembly minutes for 1908.
