### MINUTES OF PRESBYTERY

At Charlottetown, and within St. James' Hall there on Tuesday, August 28th, 1906, and at 11 o'clock forenoon, which place and date the Presbytery of Prince Edward Island met pursuant to adjournment and was constituted. Mr. John Murray moderator with whom were present Messrs R. G. Sinclair, Geo. Millar, W. H. Spencer, J. W. McKenzie, E. J. Ruttee, A. J. McNeill, D. McLeod, T. F. Fullerton, W. H. Sedgewick, A. S. Stewart, D. McNeill, A. D. McDonald, E. Smith, M. H. McLeod, R. G. Strathie, A. D. Sterling, A. Craise, ministers, and T. C. James, Hugh McMillan, Daniel McLaren, J. J. McLeod, and D. McDonald, elders. Elders' Resolutions were received from the sessions of Hampton and Bloomfield in favor of Messrs J. J. McLeod and M. D. McLeod respectively, and their names were ordered to be placed on the roll of Presbytery. The clerk was authorized to place on the roll the names of representative elders properly appointed and transmitted to him. Revs. W. P. Archibald, D. McDonald, Dr. Coffin, and John Gillis being present were invited to sit and correspond. Presbytery took up the resignation of Mr. A. D. McDonald of the pastoral charge of Tryon Hampton and Morrison, McKinnon, and Myers expressed the desire that their pastor remain among them. On motion, and with the consent of Mr. McDonald, the resignation was laid on the table until the congregation be visited in connection with the proposed re-arrangement of congregations. The committee appointed to take into consideration the state of the Church within the bounds recommended the following new arrangement of congregations:

- I. Wood Islands and Little Sands.
- II. Caledonia, Murray River, and Murray Har. S.
- III. Montague and Heatherdale.
- IV. Valleyfield and Orwell.
- V. Georgetown and Lower Montague.
- I. West River, Hampton, Tryon, and Bonshaw.
- II. Clyde River, Brookfield, and Hunter River.
- III. New Glasgow, Rustico, Cavendish, and Stanley.
- I. Alberton, Montrose, and Tignish.
- II. Bloomfield, Elmisdale, and Campbelltown.
- III. O'Leary, Brae, and West Cape.

After discussion it was moved, seconded, and carried, that the committee be thanked for their labours and instructed to continue the visitation of congregations interested, and report at a meeting of Presbytery to be held on Tuesday, Sept. 18th. Messrs Millar and McKenzie were appointed by the moderator to examine the session records of Tryon, Hampton, and Bonshaw. The clerk presented a call from Central Church, Hamilton, Ontario, addressing to Mr. W. H. Sedgewick, Zion Church, Charlottetown, and stated that the session and congregation of Zion Church had been cited to appear for their interests at a meeting of Presbytery to be held in Zion church Tuesday, Sept. 4th at 10 o'clock a. m. The action of the clerk was sustained. The treasurer of Presbytery Fund presented the following report up to date: Receipts \$171.98; expenditure \$117.82; balance on hand \$54.14. Travelling expenses paid to ministers attending quarterly meetings.—E. Smith, 2 meetings, \$2.14; A. McLean Sinclair, 1; \$1; Wm. McDonald, 2, \$3.30; R. G. Whidden, 2, \$2.10; J. W. McKenzie, 4, \$1.20; R. G. Strathie, 2, \$2.00; H. G.

**A DISH FOR TO-DAY.**  
Vegetarians will find in the September DELINEATOR a recipe for vegetable curry given by Swami Abhedananda, leader of the New York Vedanta Society. He first fries his vegetables separately in oil until they are a little more than half cooked. He then sets them aside and fries in oil, also, cloves, cardamom seeds, bay leaf, finely chopped chili peppers, etc. He then dissolves the curry powder in salted water, after which he mixes the ingredients together adding the curry last. The entire mixture is then placed in a tightly covered pan to cook gently over a slow fire until all of the vegetables become tender.
