PROHIBITION DAY AT POLICE COURT

Another Success Scored for Prohibition

Inspector Jenkins Obtains Three Convictions—The Liquor is Ordered to be Destroyed.

At the Police Court yesterday the friends of Prohibition had another successful day. Inspector Jenkins was represented by F. L. Hazard K. C. and three cases resulted in convictions, one was adjourned and one brought by Inspector Campbell was dismissed the witnesses swearing that the beer which they bought was not intoxicating to them. The first case called was the adjourned one against Joseph Pembroke, the celebrated iron brew case. The evidence of one witness was taken after which the defendant was fined \$100 or three months. Edward Collins was also fined \$100 or three months for a first offence. Frederick Murphy the former bartender at the bar in Harry Connolly's was given \$200 or four months and the liquor seized was confiscated and ordered to be destroyed. The case against Charles Collins, jr was adjourned for a week at the request of the Inspector and the case against Timothy Creamer was dismissed. The defendants were represented by Mr. Weeks and A. J. B. Mellish.
