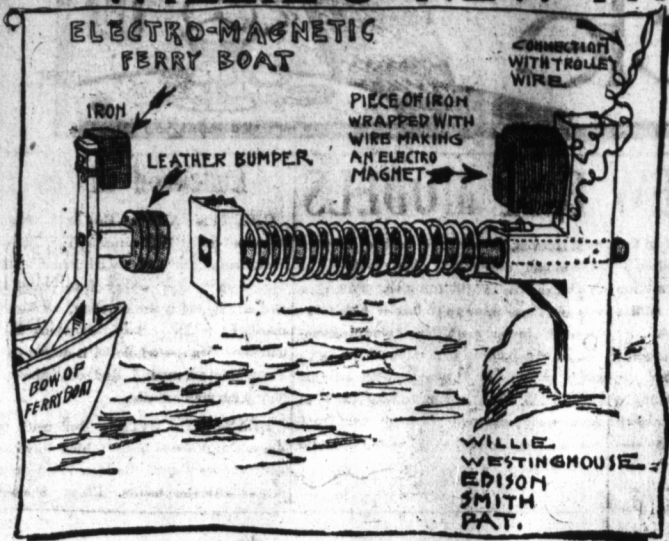
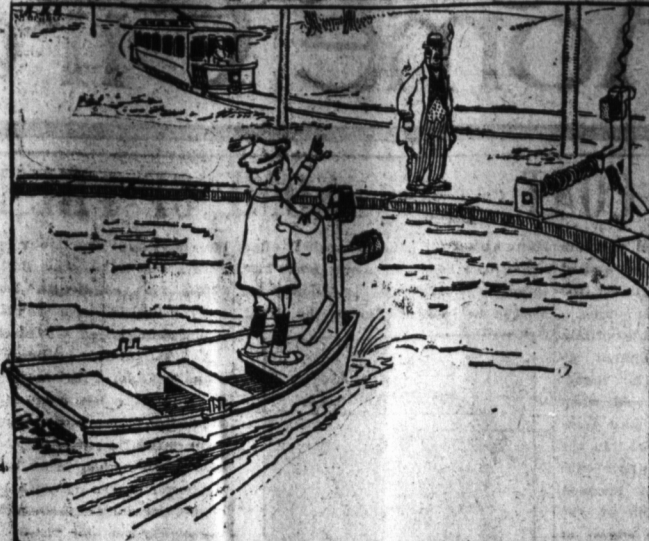

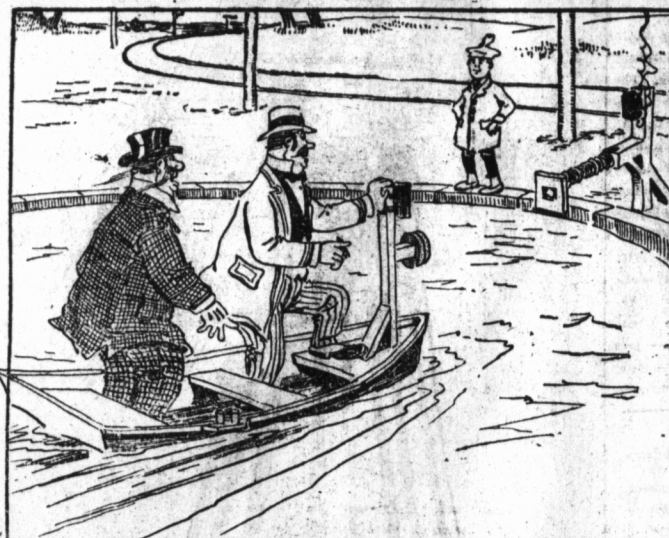
Dear Tommy: Papa took me to a rolling mill where electro magnets lift hundreds of tons. Afterward I thought out a scheme.



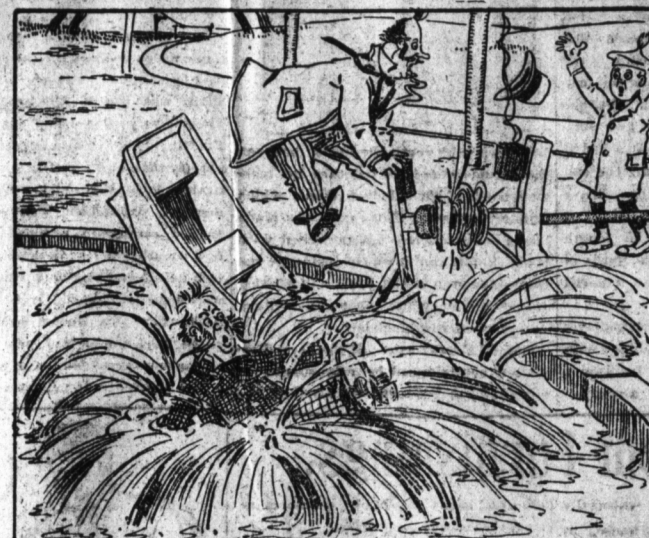
Papa is a director of the park trolley and got me permission to make a connection near the lake.

Papa was so pleased that he got the president of the road interested and he made a trip to see it work.



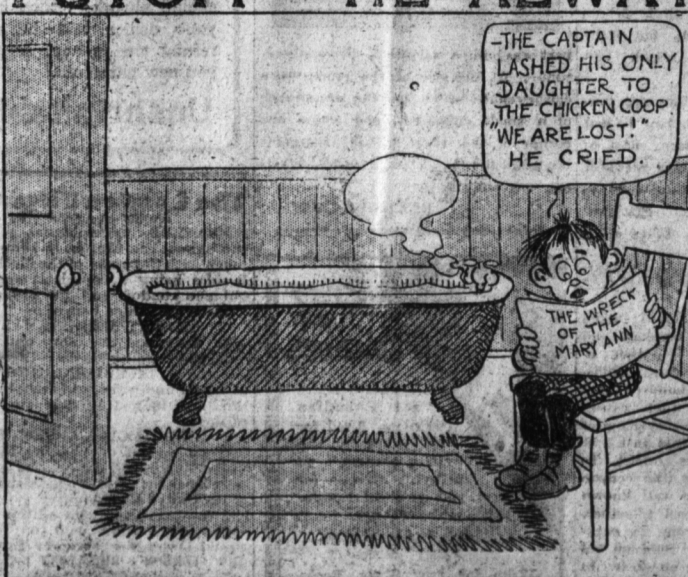
They were both so heavy that I turned on all the current, which was a mistake—
