EDMONTON, Oct. 27 — (CP) — A 16-year-old paraplegic in Dawson Creek, B.C., is going to be able to get around more easily thanks to A.M. (Al) Davey of Edmonton.

Mr. Davey recently finished building a midget automobile in his tiny garage workshop for John Bowie of Dawson Creek, who is confined to a wheelchair. The car will travel 35 miles an hour at top speed and is easily steered.

All the controls of the little gas buggy can be handled by anyone without the use of his legs. One lever operates gears, brake and throttle. It has four horsepower and sits in the front.

The rubber-tired wheels were meant for a wheel barrow, while the steering wheel is part of a discarded airplane. Mr. Davey took 14 months to build the midgeture auto at a cost of \$450.

When Mrs. J.R. Bowie read in an Edmonton newspaper about Mr. Davey's talent at building small cars, she wrote him asking if he could invent one for her son who could drive. It took a while but Mr. Davey has shipped his creation to young John.
