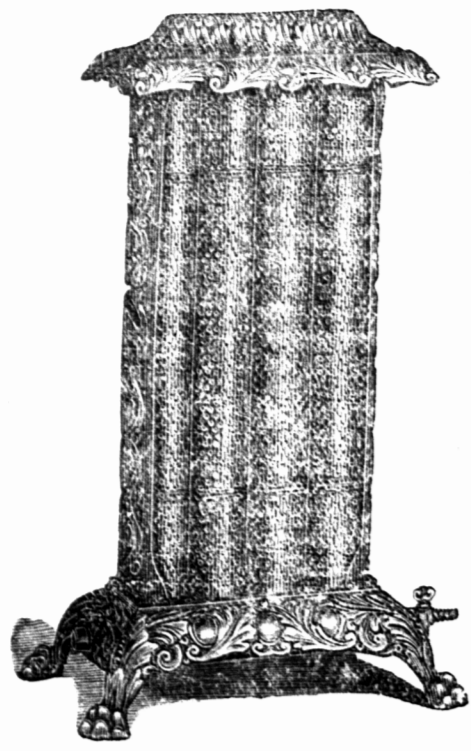
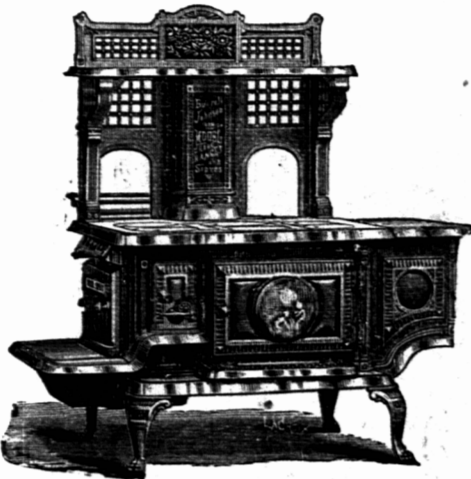

EDITOR'S MAIL.

An Inspiring Discourse Delivered by Rev. G. C. P. Palmer at Cape Traverse.

Sir,—The following notes from Rev. G. C. P. Palmer's sermon, delivered in Cape Traverse Methodist church, will be interesting to doubtful voters. His text was from Romans VIII:3—"For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God, sending His own son in the flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh." The reverend gentleman sent home to our hearts some such burning truths, that we think, had our whole nature been degraded by the power of the enemy, in his Master's name, is so nobly fighting, our even blinded eyes must have been opened by the straight-forward, common-sense logic so forcibly presented. "God the Eternal, gave first law, which, if obeyed, all need of further revelation would have been removed. God, after educating man by means of law, revealed to man His nature of love; so let us, following our Great Example, first, sober men by the conscience, the reason, the God-given intellect may be reached. Were the love of God shed abroad in every heart, all need of law, civil or moral, would be removed. Were the love of God the ruling motive of every life, there would be no need of prohibition law. No man with God's love permeating his nature deals in rum. No man with God's love for his fellowman will go to the polls on the 29th for the purpose of making the sign of the cross in the 'No' column of the prohibition ballot.

The [Scott Act] feature is no plea against prohibition. Sale of Malice prohibition law is not really prohibitory, for a law that allows liquor to be brought into a state or province is merely a form of license and not really a prohibition law.

The revenue question is no real excuse. Direct taxation on the authority of our greatest statesmen, is not necessary, as proven by the history of the temperance revolution of Ireland. History defies the enemies of temperance to contradict those statements.

"Let me appeal to you by the love I have for you, the love of a Christian heart, which yearns for your good when going to the poll, as you make the sign of the cross in the 'Yes' column, remember the greater cross, that cross which reaches from earth to heaven, that speaks of God's agony for His wandering sin-cursed children, that symbol of the world's redemption."

"Shall that sign of the cross be placed on the other side? Shall you, instead of Saviour-like uplifting your fallen brother, give your vote for the side of degradation, of vice, of the deep darkness of sin, which has in all ages followed in the train of this soul-damning traffic?"
