"See here (with a grunt of grudging approval he showed us a handful of kernels wonderfully bright and clear), these here rolls split them right along that crease and each roll (of which there may be half a dozen) breaks up the berries, just a little stronger squeeze each time."

"Now, we can make clean, pure flour (meaning FIVE ROSES, no doubt) only by gradual reduction. If I squeeze the berries too severely at first, it's sure to break the skin of the wheat, thus pulverizing the bran to a certain extent, producing what we call 'break flour'."

HALIFAX GIRL DETAINED.

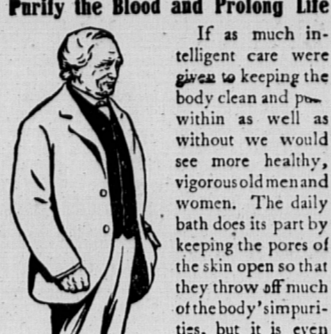
BOSTON, May 7.—Miss Ada Mulcaby, a comedy girl of 18 years, from Halifax, is detained at the United States immigration quarters.

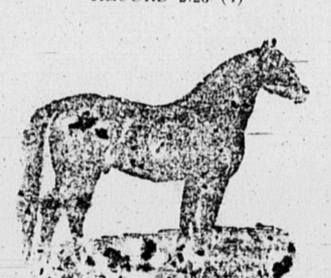

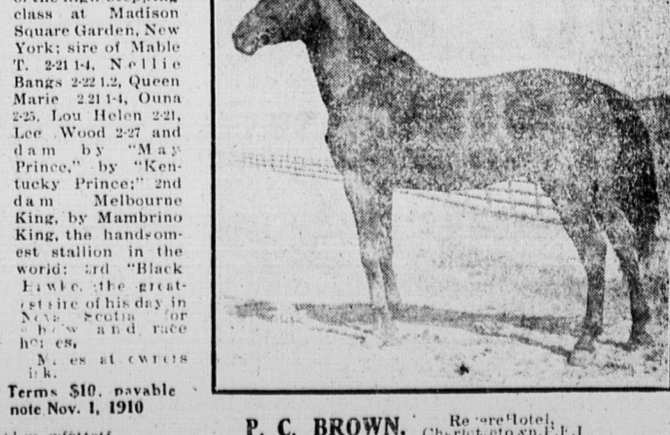
