GERMANY NOW THREATENS THE RES- TRUCTION OF PARIS.

LONDON, Oct. 30.—The Daily News correspondent at Rotterdam says that with a view to counteracting the depression caused in Germany by the German Government's ban on the export of goods, the German Anzeiger extraordinary outburst threatening the destruction of Paris by the German air forces. Instancing raids on Karlsruhe and other places, this inspired article to which great prominence is given, continues: "Do the French really seriously believe it is their defences which keep back our flyers from the heart of France? Let France not deceive herself. We have the means in our hands to insure that for every bomb which is thrown by the French in peaceable German towns, a whole street in the fortress of Paris shall sink into ruins. France must herself determine her own fate."
