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The Markets At A Glance

WINNIPEG, June 20—(CP)—Winnipeg futures prices offered good advances in the deferred months today with December reaching the five-cent maximum at one point in the trade.

CHICAGO, June 20—(AP)—A few transactions were made in oats at the ceiling level today as the grain trade awaited outcome of the controversy surrounding the Office of Price Administration. Activity in the cash market also was at a reduced level, with only 15,000 bushels of corn and 20,000 bushels of oats purchased for future delivery in morning trade.

TORONTO, June 20—(CP)—Trailing the New York market, stocks had a weak turn late in today's Toronto exchange session to net index losses for all groups. Base metal issues lost .50 and other groups had minor index losses.

NEW YORK, June 20—(AP)—Exceptionally "thin" blue chips fell sharply on relatively small sales in today's stock market and gave the overall average one of its worst beatings in the past nine years.

MONTREAL, June 20—(CP)—Easing of a number of pivotal papers in quiet trading on the Montreal stock exchange and a reb market today carried the group to 2 1/2 index loss of 5.09. Other groups showed small losses.
