OTTAWA, Jan. 4.—The Government has taken steps to implement their promise contained in a speech from the Throne for closer trade relations between Canada and the British West Indies.

Negotiations have been opened through the Imperial Government with the West Indies and the expectation is that the progress now being made will clear the way for more direct and detailed Conference between representatives of the West Indies and Canadian Government.
