DEDICATION OF BAPTIST CHURCH SUMMERSIDE

Is To Take Place On Sunday Special Services Description Of Church

Summerside, December 19—Scarcely had the members of the great fire of a year ago cooled before the Summerside Baptist Church decided to rebuild. Examination showed that the foundations were intact. The problem then was to use them, and yet build an edifice that would be modern in every particular. This problem was placed in the hands of George E. Baker, architect, of Summerside. How successfully he solved it can only be realized by viewing the building in its now completed state.

The main structure has a length over all of seventy-four feet, with width of thirty three feet. The tower is about eleven feet square, and thirty-four feet high, with a spire having twenty-four feet additional.

The design of the structure is Romanesque, which has been carried out in all details.

Entrance is by the tower, with a spacious vestibule. The view on entering the auditorium reveals a room chaste in design and yet of a richness in simplicity. The leaded glass windows, designed by Grimson & Co., of Montreal, add to the impression made upon the beholder.

The building is so arranged it can seat from two hundred and fifty to four hundred and fifty according to occasion.

Two of Doherty's finest organs were supplied by Thomas Andrew. The pews of modern mould design were manufactured by the Globe Furnishing Co., of Walkerville, Ont., and the electric lights were manufactured by McDonald and Wilson of Toronto. The electric installation was done by W. P. Deull, of Charlottetown.

The building itself, into which only the best of material enters and the finest of workmanship was employed, was erected by M. F. Schurman & Co., Ltd., and will remain a monument to their faithfulness as contractors, as well as of the skill and taste of the supervising architect, Mr. Baker. The church is equipped with two of McClary's hot air furnaces, installed by Thomas Johnston. The building, which will be dedicated next Sunday, adds to the number of beautiful churches for which this Province is becoming famous.

The dedication services on Sunday will be of a specially impressive and elaborate character. There will be three services—11 a.m., 3 p.m., and 7 p.m. There will be special music at all services. In the morning the psalm will deliver a foreword; in the afternoon addresses will be delivered by Rev. H. Johnson, R. V. B. G. S. Sathie, and Eld. R. A. J. Dwyer; and in the evening the dedication sermon will be preached by R. V. W. M. Smallman, of New Glasgow, N. S.
