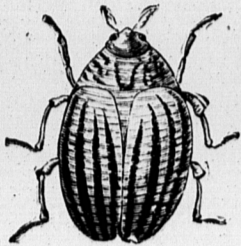

CHARLES P. KNAPP, BANKER, CONVICTED.

BINGHAMPTON, N. Y., June 26.—Chas. P. Knapp, one of the firm of Knapp Brothers, private bankers of New York, which failed over a year ago, at the time the Binghampton Trust Company doors were closed, has been convicted of receiving a deposit in his bank on the day it closed, knowing at the time that the bank was insolvent. The trial has been in progress since June 13th. Knapp has been sentenced to Auburn Prison for not less than 15 months nor more than two years.

The failure of Knapp Brothers was due to excessive and unsecured loans to the Outing Magazine publishers, and it was the crash of the banking firm that caused the suspension and subsequent liquidation of the Binghampton Trust Company.

Chas. J. Knapp, an uncle of the man just convicted and a member of Knapp Brothers, as well as President of the Binghampton Trust Company, is indicted on a similar charge.

COLEMAN, BEGINS HIS FIFTEEN-YEAR TERM IN PRISON.

GREENFIELD, Mass., June 26.—Showing but little emotion, although his cheeks were wet with the tears of his father, George W. Coleman, the self confessed embezzler of the National City Bank of Cambridge, where he was a bookkeeper, turned from the kisses of his weeping father and brother to Jailor Richardson on arriving about 4 o'clock today at the Franklin county jail, and began to serve the fifteen years' sentence as a federal prisoner. While his measurements were being taken in the guard room, his father and brother, both weeping and apparently broken-hearted, climbed back into the automobile here at Mr Stratton, of South Boston, owner of the machine and a friend of the Coleman family, awaited them.

GERMANY TO HAVE GREATEST STEAMER.

HAMBURG, June 26.—Arriving here from Potsdam yesterday, Emperor William lunched with Albert Ballin, Director-General of the HamBurg-American Steamship Line, and Marine Constructor Mews, who explained to the Emperor the plans of the new steamer which the company has decided to build immediately. This will be the largest steamship in the world, having a length between perpendiculars of 376 feet, and a breadth of 85 feet. From keel to upper deck will measure 64 feet. She will have a speed of 22 knots, and will be twice the tonnage of the Kaiserin Augusta Victoria, which is a vessel of 24,581 tons register.

ADOPT "AIRLOCKS" FOR SUBMARINES.

LONDON, June 26.—Following the disaster to the French submarine Pluviose, the Admiralty has adopted a device known as the "airlock," which has been fitted to all the new submarines in the navy. Almost simultaneously a Clerkenwell scientist named William Middleton has invented a new type of submarine which he asserts is very much safer than the present type. The "airlock" consists simply of an air-tight section built from the side of the submarine in which the air is trapped as the water fills the interior of the ship.

In the event of a mishap the crew would immediately make for the air traps, and having adjusted the life-saving jackets and helmets—which require only thirty seconds—are ready to make their escape from the torpedo hatch.

"For five thousand years," said the inventor of the new submarine, "mankind has been able to discover only four methods of propulsion through the water—the air, the revolving paddle, the revolving screw, and the jet pump.

"I have hit upon the fifth—the fin. It is no discovery; it is merely imitation of nature. The present submarines of the British navy require at least five minutes to get into a proper state for diving. Mine will disappear like a shark.

"But the newest thing about my submarine is the movable conning tower. It can either be above the deck—for the purpose of observation—or flush with it. It is also detachable. In my newest boat it is a square chamber large enough to hold three or four men. If an accident happens, press a button, and by an arrangement of compressed air pump themselves immediately to the surface. The conning tower, thus released, will float."
