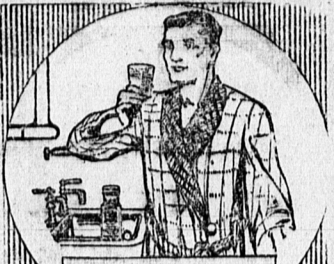
STUPENDOUS HOLIDAY BILL AT B. F. KEITH'S THEATRE BOSTON.

CHOPPED STUFF

We must change our slipshod grain farming methods, and begin to farm for profits, or not at all.

Those who have poultry should raise sunflowers. They serve to furnish shade for fowl and growing chicks during the hot days of summer.

Wherever you find corn and alfalfa, you find big red barns, tall white farm houses, fat calves and colts, fine stocks of all kinds, good towns, banks full of money!

Feed the draft colts this coming winter to develop size, bone and muscle, three essentials in all breeds of draft animals.

The quality of water required by a cow must be enormous when she yields largely. Some cows have given as much as 60 quarts of milk a day, and as milk is largely composed of water, and as water is also used by the animal for other purposes than that of entering into the composition of milk, some estimate may be made of the amount she will require.
