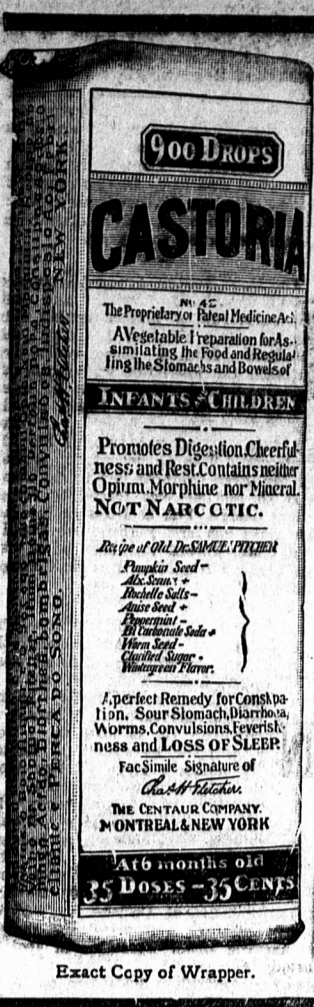

DENVER, Colo., Aug. 21.—Col. William F. Cody ("Buffalo Bill") announces that he has definitely retired from public life. Today, by order of the United States District Court, the property of the Buffalo Bill Wild West and Far East shows was disposed of at public sale in this city to satisfy the claims of creditors.

In 1867 he won his title of Buffalo Bill. It was then that a gang of 1200 men were laying the tracks of the Kansas-Pacific across the plains and he was furnishing for fresh meat.

When Buffalo Bill first launched his show, the experienced men in the business laughed at him and said that it was a wild scheme, but in less than six months he was making more money than Barnum.
