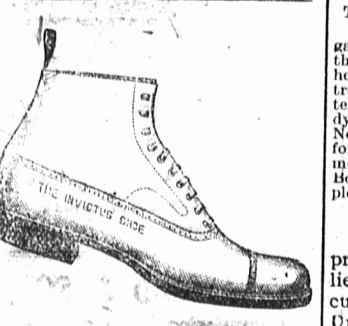
"Warburton and Prowse" will be the battle cry of Queen's County Liberals until November 3rd.

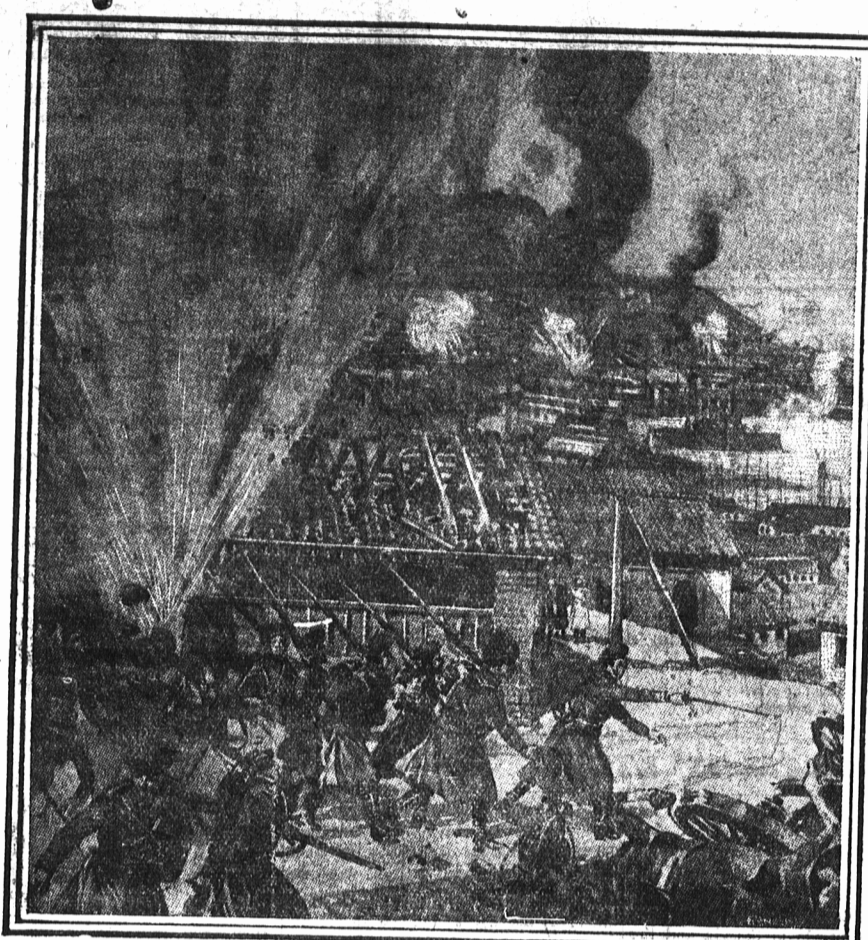
