**Stock Prices Fluctuated On Exchanges Yesterday**

NEW YORK, Jan. 21.—(AP)—The stock market failed to make any headway today for the first time this week. Turnover of 770,000 shares compared with 820,000 yesterday.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks dipped 1.1 of one point to 66. Of the 964 issues which were traded, 388 advanced and 320 declined.

A handful of shares showed comparatively wide swings. Swift & Co. advanced 1-2 to 32, apparently because a special dividend was larger than had been anticipated.

Nickel Plate, one of the more volatile railway issues, rose more than 2 at one time and finished 1-2 ahead at 79 1/4.

Among those shaded a bit were Republic Steel, Santa Fe, Southern Railway, Paramount Picture, American Can, Westinghouse Electric, General Motors, Chrysler, Montgomery Ward and Schenley.

At Toronto  
TORONTO, Jan. 21.—(CP)—Prices moved irregularly on a slightly firmer tone on the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Base metals held steady in dull action while golds and western oils slipped lower.

Frobisher shares held the spotlight in the mining list, touching a new high at \$2.50 and then settling to \$2.65, a gain of 15 cents, in brisk trading. Negotiations are in progress for the sale of 1,000,000 shares of the company's stock and optioning of more shares.

Senior golds held firm and juniors showed losses ranging up to about five cents in slow action.

Base metals moved narrowly with a few issues showing small changes. International Nickel added 1-8 at 34 7/8 and New Calumet, Reeves MacDonald, Sherritt and Eureka tightened.

Losses almost tripped gains in western oils. Pacific Petroleum and Anglo-Canadian dipped 10 cents and Okalta, Central Leduc and Dalhousie were small losers. Calgary and Edmonton added five cents at \$6.20.

At Montreal  
MONTREAL, Jan. 21.—(CP)—Minor gains and losses were well distributed among selected industrials during quiet trading on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market today. A softer undertone prevailed among slow-moving minerals.

International Petroleum was broadly traded on a turnover of 2,411 shares. The stock rose 1-5 while B. A. Oil advanced 3-8 and Consolidated Homestead added a fraction of a cent.

Imperial Oil and McColt were active and steady at 18 3/4 and 11 7/8, respectively. On a soft decline were Gaspé, Home Oil, Decalita, Anglo-Canadian and Royalite.

Consolidated Paper moved up 1-4 as Fraser added 1-8, but Abitibi Pfd was shaded. Price was unchanged at 57.

Hudson Bay Mining and Noranda slipped minor fractions in metals as Algoma Steel advanced 1-4. Seagrams dipped 1-4. In the finance group, Southmount gained two cents at 43 cents on a total of 3-965 shares traded.

Brand and Millen A dropped 15 cents to 90 in the balance of the list. Fractionally easier were Canadian Car A, Cockshutt, Dominion Bridge, Dominion Textile and Canadian Industries. Canada Cement, Dosco B, Canadian West Lumber, Cub Aircraft and Royal Bank were among gainers.

A new comer among mines on the Montreal Curb was Anacon Lead Mines Ltd., which owns a base metal property in Portneuf County, Quebec. The issue touched a new low of 62 cents, then rallied and closed at a new high of 64. Close to 10,000 shares of the new stock were sold.

Normalmetal also touched a new high, closing at \$3.45 for a gain of five cents.
